Jim Bedard (ice hockey, born 1956)

James Arthur Bédard (born November 17, 1956) is a <u>Canadian</u> retired <u>ice hockey goaltender</u>. He was most recently the goaltending coach for the <u>Detroit Red</u> Wings of the National Hockey League (NHL).^[1]

Career

Originally drafted in 1976 by the <u>Washington Capitals</u>, Bédard played for parts of two seasons with the Capitals. After playing two seasons in the minor leagues, Bédard signed to play in the <u>Finnish SM-liiga</u>, After two seasons with <u>HC TPS</u>, he played in Finland for 12 seasons more, mostly in lower divisions, before finally retiring in 1994.

After his playing career, he served as the goaltending coach with the <u>Detroit Red Wings</u> for 19 seasons. He had won three <u>Stanley Cups</u> with Detroit in <u>1998</u>, <u>2002</u> and <u>2008</u>. On May 9, 2016, it was reported that Bédard's contract with the team would not be renewed. [2]

Bédard is also the goalie coach for the Detroit Red Wings Alumni Association [3] and is active in its efforts to raise money for children's charities in Metro Detroit. As of 2016–17, Bédard is the goaltending coach for the OHL's Windsor Spitfires. Since 2017–18, Bedard has been the goaltending coach for the Texas Stars.
